#### **Dear Parents,**

#### **Warm Greetings!!**

Its SUMMER TIME again! Use Summer Vacation as an opportunity to spend quality time together. Let your child take the lead and use his/her imagination, creativity and knowledge to do the assigned task. The role of the parents is to be a facilitator and guide to steer the child in the right direction. He/She will find his own destination. Original work of students will receive greater recognition and appreciation.

(Here are for them: some tips to make this period a fruitful and happy period)

- Brush his/her teeth twice a day.
- Wash his/her hands before and after meal.
- Switch off the lights before leaving the room.
- Keep his/her things at the proper place.
- Wear his/her shoes and socks by himself or herself.
- •. Motivate the child to use polite words such as 'Please, Thank You, Sorry, May I'.
- Wish 'Good Morning and 'Good Night' to their parents and elders.
- Learn his/her parent's mobile numbers.
- Button and unbutton the shirts on its own.
- Help in the household activities.
- Encourage the child to speak simple sentences beginning with the words I, my, he, she. I am a girl /boy, My name is ...... He loves to play, She likes to eat ice cream.
- Play with the child asking him /her to touch the objects starting with the letter you call out.
- Play the game "I can touch". Ask the child to touch his/her legs and say "I can touch my legs". Do the same with different body parts.
- Recite all the rhymes done so far with actions and voice modulation.



# (For the Parents ) Reading is Fun

Children are made readers on the laps of their parents.

- Make reading a regular practice with pictures and large text.
- Make bed-time stories a part of your child's daily routine.
- Identify a family game like cricket, football, volleyball, etc. and play with your child every weekend.

#### **Get Close to Nature**

Take your child for regular morning walk to breathe in fresh air. Make him aware of the benefits of morning walk and tell him/her about different types of plants, flowers and birds so he/she can generate love for nature.




